



Father's Day Handprint Card

Activity: Create a card for Dad/Papa using your handprint to make a personalized image.

Supplies:

- piece of construction paper or cardstock
- washable paints or markers
- paintbrush (if needed)
- scissors and glue or tape

Directions:

- Fold the paper/cardstock in half to create a card.
- You will make two handprints using different colors.
- **1st Handprint:** Choose a paint color to make the **shirt** - paint it on the palm of your hand; also your thumb and pinky finger, which will be the arms/hands.
Then choose another color for the **pants** - paint it on your ring and pointer fingers. Now press your painted hand onto the bottom of the front of the card, **fingers pointing down**. Let this part of the card dry well before you start on the head part!
- Wash your hand thoroughly to get all that paint off! Dry your hand completely.
- **2nd Handprint:** When the body part is completely dry you can now paint the palm of your hand with a skin tone color paint for the **head**. Then paint your fingers the color of your Dad's/Papa's **hair**. Do not paint your thumb! Place the bottom of your painted hand just at the top of the shirt and press down well onto the card.

Finishing Touches:

- Using some colorful paper, you can add a tie or pocket onto Dad's/Papa's shirt.
- Make sure you draw on Dad's/Papa's face and give him a big smile!
