Connecting you to medical resources including primary care physicians

Mental health support

Arranging transportation to your medical visits and vaccine appointment

Services for unsafe living conditions

Coordinating food pantry services

Mobility support

Helping you sign up LINK, WIC, TANF, etc.

Immigration matters

Connecting you to resources for rental and utility assistance

Assistance with contact tracing efforts
