



Screen-Free Activity: Paper Chains

Activity:

Teaching your child to make paper chains helps with patterns and fine motor skills as they choose the next color and guide it through the previous circle.

Supplies:

Paper- cut into strips (one color or many!)
Scissors
Tape, glue, or scissors



Instructions:

- 1) Start with paper strips. The ideal size is 11.5 inch side in approximately 1 inch strips.
- 2) Decide if you'd like to make a pattern. Or choose colors as you go!
- 3) Join the two ends of a strip paper into a circle. Glue, tape, or staple.
- 4) Thread another slip of through the circle and staple/tape/glue it closed.
- 5) Continue doing this, until all the strips are gone or you're done!
